# Sea Sports Scuba Open Water Class Procedures

This form is a continuation of the terms and conditions of sale as stated on the original invoice. Student must initial and sign before class registration is accepted, and student acknowledges and accepts the requirements of enrollment into an Open Water class.

**Initials  
Required**

- A. Individuals under the age of 18 must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian for the first hour of the class and to the open water dives. \_\_\_\_\_
- B. Student must perform a swim assessment, **any style of stroke**, (no time limit) and perform a 10 minute tread or **survival float**. \_\_\_\_\_
- C. Students must attend all classroom sessions, pool sessions and open water sessions. \_\_\_\_\_
- D. **Class Pre-Work Requirements**  
 For **all** Open Water classes (Weekend, National Geographic, One Week and Two Week classes) students are responsible for completing, by the first class session:
  - (1) The entire CD-Rom or DVD (including the DVD for National Geographic class)
  - (2) Entire Textbook (including the textbook for National Geographic class)
  - (3) All Knowledge Reviews \_\_\_\_\_
- E. Each student will take 4 (four) quizzes that are to be used as a barometer of progress. \_\_\_\_\_
- F. Final Exam - Student must score at least 75% on the exam, and miss no dive table problems. \_\_\_\_\_
- G. Student must submit to Sea Sports Scuba a properly completed and signed Medical Release form (short or long version) a minimum of 72 hours before the start of Open Water Class. Without a completed Medical Release, student will not be able to participate in any pool training dives or Open Water Dives. \_\_\_\_\_
- H. **A rescheduling fee of \$95 will be charged whenever a student reschedules within 72 hours of the scheduled start date. No refunds can be issued within 72 hours of class start date.** \_\_\_\_\_
- I. **Make Up and Rescheduling Fees:** Because there is insufficient time to do class make-ups in an Open Water class schedule, students who miss any class module must reschedule to another class to complete the Open Water class requirements, and pay a rescheduling fee of \$95.00. \_\_\_\_\_
- J. Students can split classroom and pool sessions from Open Water sessions (i.e. do Open Water dives on a different date from the originally schedule Open Water date). However, this newly selected open water date must be a regularly scheduled Open Water date and the student must provide 48 hours notice prior to class commencement. A \$30 change fee applies to such a change. \_\_\_\_\_
- K. Student must provide a deposit for rental gear when taking gear to Open Water; either an imprint of a major credit card, or a check made payable to Sea Sports Scuba. \_\_\_\_\_
- L. Any scuba equipment used must meet the standards set by Sea Sports, Inc. (Black Rubber Fins and/or Exposed or Uncoated Lead are not permitted) **The student is responsible for providing their own personal diving equipment, (Scuba Quality) as defined by Sea Sports Scuba.** These items include; Diving Mask, Fins, Booties, Snorkel, Whistle, Weight belt and weights. \_\_\_\_\_

- M. Student is responsible for transportation to and from open water sites and any fees incurred in travel. Minors must be accompanied by parent or legal guardian at all open water dives. \_\_\_\_\_
- N. Students 10 or 11 years of age and one of their parents must attend an additional 30 minute session prior to the first class session. \_\_\_\_\_
- O. There will be no alcohol consumed at the Open Water dive site. \_\_\_\_\_
- P. Student is responsible for entrance fees and air fill costs at the Open Water site. \_\_\_\_\_
- Q. Each student must have their own dive tables and logbook. Log books must be filled out for each open water dive and signed by the Instructor. \_\_\_\_\_
- R. Referrals will be granted to other locations for the purpose of final certification, but we have no control over charges at these locations. Sea Sports Scuba will not refund any portion of the class fees. \_\_\_\_\_
- S. Open Water Course requirements must be completed within a 6 month period of time, including all open water dives. \_\_\_\_\_
- T. Situations sometimes occur which require classes to be cancelled or rescheduled. This usually occurs when the minimum number of students do not register for a class. Sea Sports Scuba will work closely with customers to reschedule or move the class to another store location if needed, but reserves the right to reschedule any portion of a class, if required. \_\_\_\_\_
